

5th Annual Poker Ride & Walk 2014



A Poker Ride/Walk is an organized event where participants must visit five checkpoints or stations [by horseback or walking], drawing a playing card at each one. The object is to have the best poker hand at the end of the ride/walk. The event has a time limit, however the participants are not timed.



Each participant will register and pay \$25 per poker hand. There is no limit to the number of Poker hands that may be purchased by each individual player. The best hand of Poker wins \$1000. ***New this year – Pledging – Collect pledges & win a prize. Details can be seen here. The 'Poker Ride and Walk' is open to people of all ages. People under the age of 19 may purchase a Poker Hand as long as an adult accompanies them.



Registration opens at 10am. Participants will receive a numbered sticker and a map of the poker stations. There will be 5 walking stations and 5 riding stations set up where participants will pick up their playing cards. Participants will have 2 hours to collect their cards and return them to the registration desk.
